Travel Grants for Immunologists from Developing Countries

Application Deadline: **1 March 2016**

ELIGIBILITY

1. Applicants of any career stage are eligible.
2. Applicants do NOT have to be members of any specific society.
3. Applicants must be the presenting author of an abstract submitted to ICI2016.
4. Applicants must be a citizen of a Developing Country or Advanced Developing Country as designated by the United States Agency for International Development (USAID); an applicant must also be currently working in a laboratory located in a Developing Country or Advanced Developing Country. The ICI 2016 Committee strongly encourages applications from women.

SELECTION

Grant recipients will be selected by the ICI 2016 Committee with the American Association for Immunology (AAI), BioLegend and Bill & Melinda Gates Foundation (BMGF) giving final approval. AAI and BMGF must abide by U.S. law in providing awards, specifically, regulations issued by the U.S. Department of Treasury, Office of Foreign Assets Control (OFAC.)

Preference will be given to those who are not receiving travel support from other sources to attend the ICI2016.

Successful applicants will be notified before the end of April, 2016.

AWARD

Recipients will receive their travel award (paid in AUD) onsite at the Congress. Instructions for collection of the award will be provided in due course.

APPLICATION INSTRUCTIONS

A single application is sufficient to apply for all three schemes for travel grants for immunologists from developing countries. All submissions must be entered through the online system:
